Eligibility

2. Demonstrate financial need.*
3. Have a family member who has a mental or physical disability that significantly detracts from family income.

* Need will be assessed by the Private School Aid Service (PSAS) Student Aid Form

- ✓ The Families with Special Needs Scholarship is a one-time award.
- ✓ One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1000
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
