**Water Polo Back as a School Sport** – Resurrection will be bringing back the water polo program this spring. We hope to field JV and Varsity as in past seasons. We will be conducting a coaching search over the next few weeks.

**Fall Sports Banquet - Monday, November 5<sup>th</sup> at White Eagle Banquets** – The fall sports banquet will be Monday, November 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm at White Eagle Banquets. Address is 6839 N Milwaukee Ave, Niles, IL 60714. **Reserve your spot:** To reserve your spot, send a check made out to Resurrection College Prep. Send the check in an envelope and indicate “Attn: Mr. Kane” on it. Your daughter can drop the envelop off at the main office with Ms. Carlson and she will put it in my box. In the envelope include your daughter’s first and last name, and the sport she plays. Cost is \$25 per attendee, including the athlete. So if both parents and your daughter are attending the check should be for \$75. If just one parent and your daughter are attending the check should be for \$50. I will know how many seats to reserve your family by the amount of the check. Reservations are due October 26<sup>th</sup> at the end of the school day. I know I normally am able to extend the due date, but I cannot this year. I am out of the office Nov 1-4, and need to organize all banquet items before I leave.

**Lacrosse Cuts Will Be Made This Spring** – Resurrection lacrosse has been growing by approximately 10 girls each year for the last three years. If that trend continues we would anticipate 70 girls in lacrosse this spring. This is too great a number to ensure a competitive program. At the varsity level the best players play, and at the JV level the program needs the girls with the most potential to help the varsity

team to get adequate playing time. For that reason, this spring there will be cuts in lacrosse. The coaching staff reserves the right to cut **varsity to 22 players**, and **JV to 20 players**. The coaching staff may decide to keep more on the team depending on the talent-level at tryouts, but could cut down to these amounts. **The lacrosse program will still keep all interested freshmen.** We are publishing this information now so everyone is aware that lacrosse will no longer be a no-cut program at the JV and Varsity levels.
