Golf Finishes 5th at Regionals, Qualifies Two for Sectionals – The Resurrection Golf team finished 5th place at Regionals on Wednesday, qualifying two golfers for sectionals. This is the highest team finish the coaching staff can remember, as well as the first time we have qualified 2 golfers for Sectionals. Congratulations to Madison Pronek and Mary Malausky who both qualified for Sectionals. Sarah Lach missed the cut by 1 stroke, and Eileen Schenfeld missed the cut by 2 strokes. All 13 golfers on the team plan to return next season.

Sports Banquets Will Remain at White Eagle Banquet Hall – We have determined that sports banquets will remain at the White Eagle. If you recall, the coaches asked if we could switch to having sports banquets in the Res Little Theatre. We polled the parents at the fall sports parent meeting and it was a tie. The issue was brought back to the booster club, and the club decided to poll the student-athletes. The student-athletes voted 75% to keep the banquet at the White Eagle. Lacrosse Cuts Will Be Made This Spring –Resurrection lacrosse has been growing by approximately 10 girls each year for the last three years. If that trend continues we would anticipate 70 girls in lacrosse this spring. This is too great a number to ensure a competitive program. At the varsity level the best players play, and at the JV level, the program needs the girls with the most potential to help the varsity team to get adequate playing time. For that reason, this spring there will be cuts in lacrosse. The coaching staff reserves the right to cut **varsity to 22 players**, and **JV to 20 players**. The coaching staff may decide to keep more on the team depending on the talent-level at tryouts but could cut down to these amounts. **The lacrosse program will still keep all interested freshmen.** We are publishing this information now so everyone is aware that lacrosse will no longer be a no-cut program at the JV and Varsity levels.
