**Softball Playoffs May 21 at Antioch – Don't miss the turn!!!** – Hopefully, we are celebrating a victory for our softball team on Monday, May 20, which means their next playoff game will be Tuesday, May 21 at Antioch at 4:30 pm. We played last year at Antioch and everyone (including myself) could not find their softball field. When you are heading to Antioch HS, the last few miles of the trip are on a one lane road. You need to turn off this one-lane road at the last right-hand turn before the high school. This turn is basically right before the road starts going uphill. If you start to see the Antioch Football Field or Baseball field to your right you have gone too far. Turn around and make the first left after the football field. Once on the correct street you follow this small street all the way down. When the street turns to the left there is a small uphill park entrance to your right.
