Lacrosse Cuts Will Be Made This Spring – Resurrection lacrosse has been growing by approximately 10 girls each year for the last three years. If that trend continues we would anticipate 70 girls in lacrosse this spring. This is too great a number to ensure a competitive program. At the varsity level the best players play, and at the JV level the program needs the girls with the most potential to help the varsity team to get adequate playing time. For that reason, this spring there will be cuts in lacrosse. The coaching staff reserves the right to cut **varsity to 22 players**, and **JV to 20 players**.
