**Volleyball in 4A Regional Final Thursday Night** – Volleyball won Tuesday night and will play for a 4A Regional Title this Thursday at 6:00 pm at Whitney Young. Please come out and support the team! For those that do not know, Volleyball was moved up to 4A by the IHSA this year due to their success last year in finishing second in the state. The team is playing bigger and better schools, but still has their eye on Regional and Sectional Titles.

**Cross Country Qualifies as a Team for Sectionals** – Cross country qualified as a team for Sectionals at last week's IHSA Regional meet. Cross country has accomplished this twice in the last three years, after only accomplishing it once in the previous twenty-five years. At the varsity level the best players play, and at the JV level the program needs the girls with the most potential to get adequate playing time. For that reason, this spring there will be cuts in lacrosse. The coaching staff reserves the right to cut **varsity to 22 players**, and **JV to 20 players**. The coaching staff may decide to keep more on the team depending on the talent-level at tryouts, but could cut down to these amounts. **The program will still keep all interested freshmen.** We are publishing this information now so everyone is aware that lacrosse will no longer be a no-cut program at the JV and Varsity levels.
