Lacrosse Cuts Will Be Made This Spring – Resurrection lacrosse has been growing by approximately 10 girls each year for the last three years. At the varsity level the best players play, and at the JV level the program needs the girls with the most potential to get adequate playing time. For that reason, this spring there will be cuts in lacrosse. The coaching staff reserves the right to cut **varsity to 22 players**, and **JV to 20 players**. The coaching staff may decide to keep more on the team depending on the talent-level at tryouts, but could cut down to these amounts. **The program will still keep all interested freshmen.** We are publishing this information now so everyone is aware that lacrosse will no longer be a no-cut program at the JV and Varsity levels.
