



The Nicole Brunke Scholarship

Nicole Brunke, a graduate of Resurrection College Prep High School's class of 1989, dedicated her life to caring for other people. Nicole found her calling to become a nurse at a young age. She began volunteering at Resurrection Hospital as a candy striper when she was only 12 years old, and advanced to a position as nursing assistant when she turned 16. She especially loved working on the pediatrics floor spending time cheering up the children. Aside from all her time spent at the hospital, Nicole was an active student at Res. She was a crew member for two Little Theatre productions, a member of both the Spanish and Science clubs, and waitressed at the Resurrection Retirement Community.

Nicole graduated with an Associate Degree in Nursing in 1992 and became a Registered Nurse. After working at Resurrection Hospital for 3 years, she decided she wanted to experience other parts of the United States, so she enrolled in a traveling nursing program and worked in hospitals in Florida, New York, and California. Nicole returned to Chicago to work in Northwestern Medical Center's Intensive Care Unit in 1997. In her time away from work, she volunteered at a medical clinic for the underprivileged. On a more personal note, Nicole loved spending time with friends and family. She enjoyed baking and cooking, offering friends and family samples of and copies of new recipes.

Nicole had a great love of life and was always seeking out new experiences. She had made her life's work helping others. Unfortunately, Nicole's life was cut short when she was involved in a fatal automobile accident on May 23, 1998. She will always be remembered for the big smile she offered to everyone she met. In honor of Nicole, the Brunke family has set up an endowed scholarship fund to award a partial tuition scholarship annually to one Res student.

Eligibility

2. Demonstrate financial need.*
