



The Dr. Carrie Jaworski Leadership Scholarship

This scholarship is established through the generosity of Carrie Hall Jaworski '88 in order to recognize a current freshman, sophomore or junior student who shares her leadership abilities with the community. Dr. Jaworski is the Director of the Division of Primary Care Sports Medicine at NorthShore University HealthSystem and is a Clinical Assistant Professor of Family Medicine at the University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine. She previously served for four years as the Head Team Physician and Director of Intercollegiate Sports Medicine at Northwestern University where she was one of only a few women Head Team Physicians at the NCAA Division I level. Prior to taking that position, Dr. Jaworski established the Sports Medicine Center at Resurrection Medical Center, where she often hosted Resurrection students during their Health Careers Practicum, and served as the school's volunteer team physician. She believes the leadership opportunities Resurrection College Prep High School provided to her as a young woman were instrumental in her future successes. For that reason, she wants to help other young women reach their leadership potential as well. Dr. Jaworski lives in nearby Edison Park with her daughters Grace and Sara.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a current freshman, sophomore or junior student enrolled for the following school year.
2. Demonstrate financial need.*
3. Exhibit leadership through her parish, school, volunteer efforts, scouts or other activities.
