



The Dr. Chris Kelly Student Mentor Scholarship

Dr Chris Kelly, Resurrection High School Class of '59 – Wife, Mother, Teacher and Mentor. While raising three children, Dr. Kelly taught Mathematics at Resurrection College Prep High School spanning a 30-year period. In addition to this, she was a member of the Resurrection College Prep High School Board, Resurrection Hospital Board of Directors and an advisor to several Catholic elementary school boards. Her commitment to mentoring led her to create the Practicum Program at Resurrection College Prep High School. From 1998 to 2008, she served as a Professor of Education at Dominican University, teaching and mentoring high school and elementary school teachers who were to preparing to become principals. She was a firm believer in mentoring students and teachers. This scholarship is intended to promote and continue her legacy through mentoring.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a current freshman, sophomore or junior student enrolled for the following school year.
 2. Demonstrate financial need. Need is demonstrated by completing and filing the FACTS Student Aid Application.
 3. Consistently provide tutorial or mentoring services to other students.
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- ✓ The Dr. Chris Kelly Student Mentor Scholarship is a one-time award.
 - ✓ One scholarship is awarded each year in the amount of \$2,000.
 - ✓ Recipient must continue mentoring during the school year for which the scholarship is awarded.
 - ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
 - ✓ Preference will be given to students mentoring/tutoring in math, but all student mentors are encouraged to apply.
