Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a current freshman, sophomore or junior student enrolled for the following school year.
2. Complete the FACTS Student Aid Application.
3. Is currently participating in Journalism at Resurrection as a member of the Res Banner or Allegiance Staff.

- ✓ The Patty Kusinski Scholarship is a one-time award.
- ✓ One scholarship is awarded each year in the amount of \$2,000.
- ✓ Application and essay are required for this scholarship.
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
