Jessica was a Sociology student at St. Norbert College in DePere, WI when she died suddenly of a medical condition. She was president of the Epsilon xi sorority. While at Resurrection, Jessica was a member of the National Honor Society, Key Club and Math Club. Jessica demonstrated a love of life that radiated through her positive attitude and friendly demeanor. Jessica touched the hearts of many and will be truly missed by her family and many friends. The Jessica Martin Scholarship was established by an anonymous donor to honor the life and joy Jessica Martin shared with the world.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a junior level student in good standing at Resurrection College Prep High School *and* enrolled for the following school year. The scholarship will be applied towards senior year tuition.
2. Maintain a C average or better.
3. Demonstrate financial need.*
4. Be involved in at least one extra-curricular activity in school or service activity in school, parish or community
5. Emulate the qualities Jessica Martin possessed: Responsible, friendly, exhibit a love of life, and maintain a positive attitude.

* Need will be assessed by the FACTS Student Financial Aid Form – This form must be completed and submitted prior to consideration for this scholarship.

- ✓ The Jessica Martin Scholarship is a \$1,000 one-time award.
- ✓ One \$1,000 scholarship is awarded each year.
- ✓ Current junior students will be considered eligible for this award given for the following school year.
- ✓ Application and essay are required for this scholarship.
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.

**Applications must be returned no later than January 8, 2019.
Award will be presented at the beginning of the 2019-20 school year.**
