Throughout her months of cancer treatments, Tori had a strong commitment to her academics and displayed a great sense of humor and a determined, winning attitude. Tori was an unselfish, true friend and an example to all of courage and tenacity. In the spirit of Bandit Pride, she was a proud team member of the Resurrection College Prep Bowling Team.

The Tori Neumann Scholarship was established by Tori's friends and family in memory of her remarkable courage, faith and Resurrection spirit. This annual scholarship recognizes students who are facing a personal challenge with the inner strength, faith, courage and tenacity that Tori maintained during her battle with cancer.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. A current freshman, sophomore or junior student enrolled for the following school year.
 2. Complete the FACTS Student Aid Application.
 3. Demonstrate in writing how she has overcome or is facing a challenging situation with courage, inner strength and tenacity in the spirit of a young woman of Resurrection.
- ✓ The Tori Neumann Scholarship is a one-time award.
 - ✓ One scholarship is awarded each year in the amount of \$1,500.
 - ✓ Application and essay are required for this scholarship.
 - ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
