The Mark Teach Scholarship is named for the son of Gordon and Mary Teach. Gordon Teach was a friend of the Sisters of the Resurrection for over 35 years, beginning when he first served as trustee for Resurrection Health Care. Highly impressed with the various functions that he attended at Resurrection High School over the years, he felt inspired to help with the Sisters' mission of educating young women. The hard work of the Sisters played a large part in Mr. Teach's decision to establish a scholarship. The scholarship is named in honor of his son Mark, who died in infancy.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a current freshman, sophomore, junior student in good standing at Resurrection College Prep High School.
2. Demonstrate financial need.*
3. Have current (or recent) volunteer/work experience at Resurrection Medical Center.
4. Must have interest in pursuing a health-related career.
