Resurrection College Prep High School students are taking an active role in planning the **2011 Northwest Side Hunger Walk**, which will be held on **Sunday, September 25, 2011** in order to raise awareness and funds to reduce hunger in the local community and throughout the world. The theme for the walk is *We Walk Today So That Families Can Eat Tomorrow*. The Northwest Side Hunger Walk is an ecumenical effort by local churches and the community. The planning of the walk has been coordinated by representatives of Resurrection College Prep High School and churches in the Norwood Park and Edison Park neighborhoods. Funds will be donated to New Hope Methodist Food Pantry which serves neighborhood residents on the northwest side Chicago, to Catholic Charities which serves the Chicago-land area, and to Heifer International which serves the international community.

Officers of the Resurrection Key Club and other clubs hosted a leadership breakfast on Friday, September 2, 2011. Resurrection students, including officers and moderators of all clubs at Resurrection, had the opportunity to hear speakers provide local, regional and world-wide perspectives on hunger issues.
