Lisa Zago-Martin '97 – Dinosaur Hunter



Res alumna **Lisa Zago-Martin '97** is a scientist, adventurer, entrepreneur and educator who is pursuing her dreams by bringing the art and science of paleontology to the public.

Like many mothers of young children, Lisa's children, eight year old Breanna and four year old Marc Liam, inspired her to explore her passion.

For Lisa, her heart's desire since childhood was to dig up dinosaurs. Lisa is now the co-director of *Dinosauria*, a Park Ridge, Illinois based educational program about the age of the dinosaurs.

The *Dinosauria* team includes Lisa Zago-Martin and her colleague Don Pfister. Together they have

excavated dinosaur bones and other fossil specimens at the Red Canyon Ranch in Shell, Wyoming. They prepare the specimens in the *Dinosauria* lab in Park Ridge. The *Dinosauria* team shares information about dinosaurs through interactive experiences at museums, schools, libraries and special events.

Lisa's journey back millions of years was not a direct path from childhood to the Jurassic age. After graduating from Immaculate Conception School, Lisa continued on to Resurrection High School. When Lisa graduated from Resurrection in 1997 she pursued a degree in business administration.

Her path changed when she met her husband, married

and started a family. Lisa says that during the magical years when her children were babies, she was inspired by everything that brought her to this point. It was during that time that she decided to pursue her dreams of working in the field of paleontology.

Below is Lisa's account of her journey to pursue her passion and the role of Resurrection High School in her life.

While raising my babies, my focus and curiosity about the age of dinosaurs became more intense than ever. It started out with independent study, trips to the museum, and attending lectures on the subject of dinosaurs. While attending a lecture about dinosaur digs, I made a connection and began working at a dig site in Shell,

Wyoming. This was the opportunity of a lifetime to learn about dinosaur bones and other fossils, hands on at a productive dig site.

Every summer since my original expedition, I have made several trips out to this site. In Wyoming, I trained under geologist Bob Simon and worked to uncover beautiful, nearly complete Jurassic age dinosaurs with his renowned team. I have spent the winter preparing dinosaur bones for study at the University of Chicago's fossil lab.

My life thus far has been a fantastic journey. I am a deliberate creator of my life and this is my vision come true. Resurrection is one of the reasons that I am on this path. I will be forever grateful to Resurrection. The positive influence of my Catholic education is remarkable. At Resurrection I acquired good values, an excellent education and the foundation for being a strong and secure woman.

My time at Resurrection taught me to have an honorable code of behavior, which has served me well in business as well as in personal situations. As a young woman, Resurrection gave me support, which resulted in high self-esteem. I walked away from high school eager, passionate, and in control because of the good people at Resurrection who believed in me."
