From the Res Library...

Currently Available

Resurrection students, staff and parents can access the Resurrection College Prep High School library from the Res website. Your daughter can access **all** of our existing databases at any time of day or night. She can do this from home or school.

Please take a few minutes to explore the resources that are currently available on the Res library site. Ask your daughter to stop by the library for a Pink Sheet with the passwords to access the various databases or check EdLine for these database passwords. In accordance with licensing agreements we are unable to publish passwords on a site that is not password protected.

Coming Soon to a School Library Near You: Virtual Reference

Michael Gorman, former President of the American Library Association, opened an address at the Sofia 2006 Conference discussing what makes a book a book. Gorman emphasized that the physical book is merely the vehicle in which the text is delivered. It is "texts that are important not the carrier in which they are contained."¹

There are many people who believe that the physical book is more valuable than the digital version. However, the content is the same. In a library, such as the one at Resurrection, the physical book has limitations, especially a physical reference book.

The physical reference book, in any library, is only available during library hours and only has one user at a time. With the increasing availability of eBooks, many publishers are now publishing traditional reference books in a digital format. This new formatting makes a library's reference collection available 24/7. And most of these titles are available with unlimited simultaneous usage.

GALE CENGAGE Learning™ is helping schools like ours begin building our Virtual Reference Collection by offering substantial discounts this year. The Resurrection Parents Club donated a generous amount toward this collection. Also, Kim & Scott's Gourmet Pretzel Co. contributed 25 boxes of chocolate covered pretzels to sell with proceeds going towards our the collection. With these generous gifts the library should be able to purchase nearly \$12,000 of eReference books for about \$3,500 during this school year. The Virtual Reference Collection will be available to Res students through the Resurrection website.

To access databases on the Res library site:



- Select the Quick Links tab on the top right hand side of the Res website.
- Scroll down and select Destiny.
- Click on Resurrection High School.
- Click the Visual tab on the top right hand side of the Search Box.
- Select Library Databases.

The current generation of students is accustomed to accessing information online and conducting the majority of their research in the databases and through Internet searches. The entire Virtual Reference Collection will be searchable the same way a student searches for information in a database or online. Having access to actual reference books online will provide Res students with a broader depth of knowledge in their library without walls.

If you are passionate about library sciences, learning and expanding the availability of resources to our students, we encourage donations in direct support of the Resurrection library. Seventh and eighth grade girls are invited to shadow a current Resurrection student in order to experience the school first-hand. In the past few months we have **welcomed 202 eighth grade girls** as Shadow Day visitors.

Shadow Days are available for eighth grade girls from September to December and for seventh and eighth grade girls from January to May.

Development staff members have completed the fall recruiting season. In the past few months they **visited over 93 grammar schools, religious education programs and high school fairs** to provide information about Resurrection to potential students and their families.

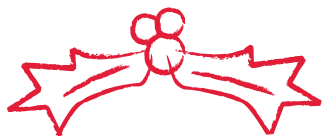
Holiday Dance Showcase
