Spring 2012 Adult Enrichment Course “Hitler’s Germany & the Chicago Connection”

Join the Spring 2012 Adult Enrichment Course at Resurrection as course participants explore Hitler’s Germany and the Chicago connection. The group will read Erik Larson’s new historic narrative *In the Garden of Beasts: Love, Terror, and an American Family in Hitler’s Berlin*. The author of *Devil in the White City*, Larson takes readers into Germany and the world as it was in 1933 while following the life of Professor William E. Dodd from Chicago. Dodd goes to Berlin, along with his family, as America’s first ambassador to Hitler’s Germany. The reader has the opportunity to watch history unfold in this engrossing narrative.

Participants will also read *The Book Thief*, an historical novel by Markus Zusak and will study sections of William Shirer’s *The Rise and Fall of the Third Reich*. The course will be taught by Resurrection faculty member Mr. Mike Longo, who holds a master’s degree in Music and Humanities from DePaul University.

During Catholic Schools Week we celebrate what makes Resurrection College Prep High School a unique place of learning and community of faith.

Students may wear **Spirit Apparel on Monday and Tuesday**, but must be in **complete uniform on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday**.

Monday, January 30, 2012 Theme: "Faith"

We will open Catholic Schools Week in prayer and senior student retreat leaders will share short testimonials about their faith at the beginning of each class period to help prepare underclass students for their retreat day on Tuesday. We will celebrate together with the Winter Pep Rally in the gym at the end of the school day.

In keeping with the theme of "Service," service type outfits may be worn in addition to Spirit Apparel. If students choose to wear service type outfits they must be respectful of the professions that they represent and in keeping with the theme for each level, as follows: Seniors - Armed Forces; Juniors - Police Personnel; Sophomores - Health Care Professionals; Freshmen - Firefighters. We honor the women and men who provide service to our nation and our communities.

Tuesday, January 31, 2012 Retreat day for freshmen, sophomores and juniors. No school for seniors.

All staff members and senior volunteers are invited to a Continental Breakfast in the staff dining room beginning at 7:15 am. Lunch will be provided to all staff and students. Freshmen and sophomore students will attend a performance called *Show Some Respect* at Resurrection conducted by the Imagination Theater, Inc. Freshmen, sophomores and juniors will be in retreat all day and will be dismissed at 2 pm.

Freshmen: Retreat theme: "The Word"

The freshmen retreat focusing on God's Word will be held at school and senior volunteers will help lead the retreat sessions.

Sophomores: Retreat theme: "Decision Making"

The sophomore retreat focusing on moral decision making will be held at school and senior volunteers will help lead the retreat sessions.

Juniors: Retreat theme: "Christian Love"

The juniors will report to seminar, attendance will be taken and then they will board busses to St. John Brebeuf Parish Center in Niles. The retreat will be led by Christian musician MashetiMoses and his retreat team. Using a blend of electronic, rap and rock music, MashetiMoses presents an engaging multimedia production, incorporating video, live musicians, praise and worship, and ministry at schools and universities around the world. The retreat will end at 1:30 pm, students will return to Resurrection and then be dismissed.

Wednesday, February 1, 2012 Theme: "Academics"

Academic achievement and learning will be celebrated in a special way. Students will watch or participate in a "quiz show" type competition. Contestants from each level will compete to answer questions generated by each of the academic departments at Resurrection.

The Student Council Variety Show performance will be at 7 pm.

Thursday, February 2, 2012 Theme: "Service"

The Resurrection Campus Ministry team will sponsor a warm-clothing drive in which students are encouraged to donate new or gently used coats, hats, gloves, scarfs and other warm clothing that will be given to Catholic Charities. 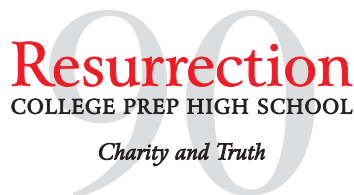

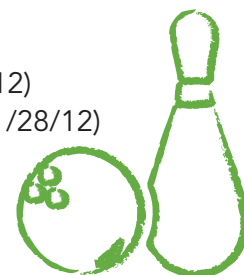

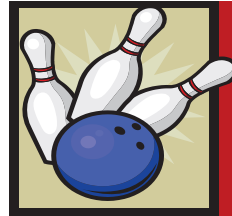

Goal: Get a walk-on spot.

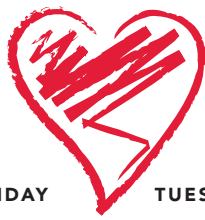
