## Skype with author Ally Condie

On Tuesday, December 6, 2011 the Resurrection library hosted an interview with Ally Condie, the author of the *New York Times* bestselling novel *Matched*. Students and staff at Resurrection have been exploring the themes in the book, which was selected for the **One School, One Book** program. Discussions have taken place around various themes in the novel.

Ally Condie is a young adult author who lives outside Salt Lake City, Utah with her husband and three sons. She is a former high school English teacher whose *Matched* trilogy is popular with teens. The trilogy is about a future society in which Society Officials decide what is best for each person in order to remove the "burden" of choice.

*Matched* follows the character Cassia as she unexpectedly faces choices about her marriage match selection that is the result of an error by Society Officials. The second book in the trilogy, *Crossed*, has recently been released and continues to follow Cassia as she explores rebellion against the Society and her relationships with Ky and Xander, her two possible marriage matches.

The interview with Ally Condie was conducted via Skype during lunch periods in the school library and gave students the opportunity to ask the author questions about the novel and characters, the issues of choice and personal freedom, the writing process, and future novels. ## **Political Science Class Takes Action** **Bi-Partisan Bake Sale: *Baking Across the Aisle***

Frustrated by the recent failure of the Senate Super Committee to compromise on a way to reduce the federal deficit, students in the Resurrection's Accelerated Political Science class hosted an assembly on Tuesday, December 13, 2011 to speak to fellow students about the need for bipartisan cooperation from both Democrats and Republicans. The class members decided to launch a symbolic project named "**The Bipartisan Bake Sale: *Baking Across the Aisle***" in order to demonstrate that students of differing political views can work together to create solutions to problems facing the nation.

Students invited local politicians to attend. State Representative Michael McAuliffe, Chief of Staff Kim Stark for State Senator John Mulroe, and Chicago Aldermen Mary O' Connor (41st Ward) and John Arena (45th Ward) attended the student presentation in support of the students' efforts and to listen to their concerns and

solutions. Alderman O'Connor, an alumna of Resurrection, stressed the importance of young women's involvement in the political process.

U.S. Representative Jan Schakowsky also expressed her support for this project and will be speaking to students at Resurrection on January 12, 2012 on the issues of bipartisan cooperation, the federal deficit, budgetary issues and political involvement by students.

During the assembly the members of the Political Science class presented information about the national deficit and how it impacts students and their families. They urged classmates to write to their elected officials and to support the bake sale, which was held the next day. "I am so proud that my students took initiative and started this grassroots effort," said Political Science teacher Denise Lenihan. "These young women impress me daily with

their motivation and desire to positively impact their community. I am hopeful that their effort can convince others to voice their concerns to their representatives."

"The Bipartisan Bake Sale" was held on December 14, 2011 and raised over \$500, which included contributions from Alderman O'Connor, State Representative McAuliffe and State Senator Mulroe. Funds raised from the bake sale will be sent to Congress as both a real and symbolic effort to reduce the national debt. Along with the contribution to the federal deficit, students have included a letter to U.S. Senator Dick Durbin, the senior senator from Illinois who has worked closely on the deficit proposals that went through Congress this fall. The students are looking forward to continuing the discussion on these important issues and are planning another event for the second semester of the school year.

### **Freshmen B Basketball** - Coach Lauren Del Boccio

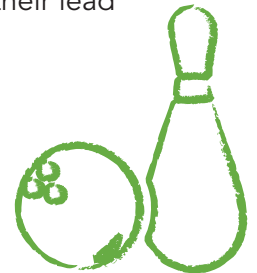
