## Varsity & JV Volleyball

The Resurrection **Varsity Volleyball** team's win-loss record is 11-5. The Res Bandits took 5th overall in the Conant/Fremd Early Bird tournament on September 3rd and 4th. The Bandits took Fremd High School, their only loss of the tournament, to 3 sets. The Varsity Bandits also took second place in our own Bandit Invite on September 11th, remaining undefeated all the way to the championship. The team also took second place in 3 very close sets against an outstanding Benet Academy.

The **JV Volleyball** team opened the season with a win-loss record of 4-1. The girls' only loss was a tough battle in 3 games to St. Ignatius. The Bandits high point was during their game against the conference rival Regina, where they saw not just incredible serving, but also a very aggressive hitting team. In addition to the offensive power, after many hours of practice spent on blocking techniques, the Bandits are experiencing success at the net!

## Freshman A Volleyball: Overall Record 2-3, Conference Record 1-2

The **Freshman A Volleyball** team had a shaky start to the season, but never gave up. Their two big victories thus far have been against St. Viator and Regina Dominican. The highlight of the season, despite the overall result, was the game against Queen of Peace. This was a tough game in which the Bandits never gave up. After losing game one 15-25, and starting off the second game down 3-11, the Bandits fought back to take game two 25-22. Unfortunately, the Bandits just fell short of the victory in the third game 13-15. Even though the Bandits did not come out on top, the Res coaches were really proud of the girls' continuous fight until the end. They have been working extremely hard and all their hard work will pay off in the end.

## Freshman B: Overall Record 4-1, Conference Record 3-0

The **Freshman B Volleyball** team has had an excellent season thus far. They are on a 4 game winning streak! The only loss of the season was their first game against Oak Park River Forest. The Bandits battled in 3 games just falling short in the third (scores: 20-25, 25-18, and 24-26). They have competed against some top notch teams including St. Ignatius, St. Viator, Regina Dominican, and Queen of Peace, never giving up and coming out on top.

## JV Tennis

The **JV Tennis** team has a record of 4 wins, 4 losses, 3 Conference wins, 1 Conference loss. The top Bandit performer is **Jennifer Pawelski '12**, 1st singles, with 5 wins at that position. The team handled some tough competition as they competed in the Niles West Invite on September 25<sup>th</sup>. All team members are improving with each match and the team is looking to be strong for Conference Tournament on October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## Varsity Tennis

The **Varsity Tennis** team is currently 4-1 (overall 4-4) in conference play. The Bandits are off to a very strong start this season following its first conference tournament championship last season. They have been led by the strong play of number one singles player **Kelly Lechowski '12**. Kelly has started the season with an overall record of 7-1 (6-1 in singles) and she is a contender for the GCAC conference player of the year award for the third straight season. In doubles, Resurrection has been led by senior captains **Jamie Steier '11** and **Stacey Buss '11**. Jamie and Stacey have a record this season of 5-3 at #1 doubles. Resurrection will continue to build momentum as they lead up to the conference and sectional tournaments later this season.

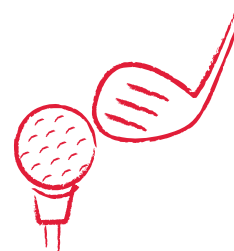

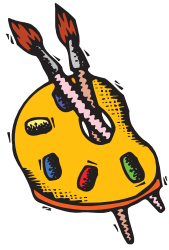

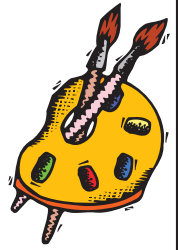
