## President's Message

Dear Families and Friends of Resurrection:

We have already begun the celebration of our 90th year with many events: the all school Mass and Picnic, Back-to-School Night, Grandparents Dinner, College Night and the Junior Ring Mass. As we enter October we celebrate Spirit Week, our first Pep Rally, and the annual Walk-A-Thon to the Pickwick. Many more activities are planned in the coming months that we hope you will be able to attend. Additional information is available in this issue.

Though it seems that conversations, radio, television, on-line news and the daily paper are filled with ongoing topics and opinions about the economy, the reality is that our families, extended family members, and friends are being impacted in one way or another. What is perhaps most surprising to many is the number of people who never thought they would find themselves in what, in some cases, are dire situations.

We know this to be true at Res because of the 78% increase since 2007-2008 in the number of requests for tuition assistance. We also know this to be true by the number of families that registered their 8th grade daughter but did not complete the process because of the amount of needed tuition assistance and because of their own financial uncertainties.

As a Catholic school, founded on the teachings of Jesus and His message of hope, our ministry extends beyond educating young women. Whether your own family, a member of your extended family, or perhaps a friend or neighbor is in need of some help at this time, we would like to inform you of two local resources.

For the 26th year our students and staff participated in the Northwest Side Hunger Walk led by Mr. Mike Longo. The funds raised by the walk helped support local organizations: the New Hope United Methodist Food Pantry [www.newhopechicago.org](http://www.newhopechicago.org) that is minutes from Resurrection and is open to anyone; and, Catholic Charities [www.catholiccharities.net](http://www.catholiccharities.net), which has numerous services available, both long and short term, for individuals and families and is a comprehensive source of assistance throughout the Chicago area.

Our theme this year is **Gratitude**. We have so many reasons to be grateful; not only for what we have but more importantly for whom we are before God and to each other. We thank you for your on-going support and for sharing the wonder of your daughter with us at this time in her life.
