Res Awarded Blue Ribbon in Health Education

Resurrection College Prep High School has been selected as the first private school in Illinois to receive a Blue Ribbon in Health Education. The Blue Ribbon Award in Health Education was developed as a joint effort between Illinois School Health Association (ISHA) and Illinois Association of Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (IAHPERD). The goal of the health education curriculum at Resurrection College Prep High School is the development of attitudes, values, and skills necessary for students to lead physically, socially, and emotionally healthy lives.

In order to qualify for the award, Resurrection completed a self-study of the school's health curriculum and reviewed the school's curriculum goals and objectives, content, and instructional strategies. The completed self-study was then submitted to the Blue Ribbon Committee for further review and a team from the ISHA and IAHPERD visited Resurrection for an in-depth look at the program. The award was developed using guidelines established by the Illinois Learning Standards, the Illinois School Code, and the National Health Education Standards.

At Resurrection, health and wellness are promoted through various programs and practices. Fitness, disease prevention,

character development and mental health are all addressed at Resurrection. The school also offers clubs which focus on wellness, including Yoga Club, Stress Busters Club, Health Careers Club, Go Green Club, and Students Against Destructive Decisions (SADD). The student newspaper, the *Res Banner*, regularly features stories on health, nutrition and wellness; and Resurrection partners with community members each year to offer Wellness Week.

Guest speakers are frequently invited to address parents and students on health related topics, such as bullying, drug and alcohol prevention, and dating violence. The school also offers opportunities for students to learn about careers in healthcare and wellness with the Resurrection Practicum Program, a job shadowing program for students. "This award validates the support that our health curriculum has from other disciplines in the school community," said Marcia Berke, Chair of the Resurrection Physical Education Department.

The Blue Ribbon Award recognizes high quality high school health programs in Illinois. Resurrection is only the 7th high school in Illinois to receive this prestigious award. The award will be presented on November 18, 2010 at a dinner to be held at Pheasant Run in St. Charles.
