

The Prom will be held at: Resurrection College Prep High School Saturday, May 15, 2021 6:00 – 9:00 p.m.

PROM RULES

We hope that your Prom will be a wonderful and memorable event for you. It should be one of the highlights of your junior year so we ask that everyone commits to helping make this a wonderful evening. The following is a list of required etiquette that all participants in the Prom commit to:

- Junior Prom is a formal/semi-formal dinner/dance for Resurrection Juniors. For the safety of all, juniors attending Prom must submit the **Prom Agreement form AND \$60 to the main office by Monday, May 10th.**
- The dance will be held at Resurrection College prep at the east end (softball field) of the student parking lot. Students may park in the lot in the designated areas on the west end (Oriole) of the parking lot.
- The dance will begin at **6:00 p.m. and end at 9:00 p.m.** You must arrive by **6:30 p.m. or you will not be admitted.** If you are not at the dance by 6:30 p.m., your parent/guardian will be called. **NO ONE WILL BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE BEFORE 8:30 p.m. Once you leave, you will not be readmitted.**
- It is illegal and unwise to use drugs and/or alcohol prior to, during, or after the dance. Cigarette smoking/vaping is strictly prohibited. Any cigarettes/vaping items found in your possession will be confiscated. The police will be called if a junior is found to possess drugs or alcohol. Their

parents will be notified. Anyone suspected of being under the influence of alcohol will be asked to submit to a Breathalyzer test. If a student tests positive for alcohol use, the parent(s)/ guardian(s) of that individual will be notified and the junior will leave with her parents.

- If a Resurrection College Prep junior is found to be under the influence of alcohol substance and/or in possession of such before or during the dance, she will not be readmitted to classes until a meeting between the parents / guardians, junior, the principal and the dean of students takes place. A referral for immediate intervention of addictive behavior will be made at that time. In either case, the junior may additionally meet with the behavior review board that will recommend consequences to the principal.
- Juniors are expected to respect the order and cleanliness of the Resurrection grounds and building and to respect faculty and security staff who are chaperoning the dance.
- Remember that this is a high school Prom. Attire is semi-formal or formal. Dresses are to cover the body completely. Short dresses must be no more than 3" above the knee. Please cover any tattoos or body piercings. As the dance will be taking place on the black top of the parking lot, shoes with soles are to be worn AT ALL TIMES. If you anticipate that your shoes will become uncomfortable, a spare pair of shoes MUST be brought with you. NO bare feet or socks will be permitted. Inappropriate attire will be addressed, and a junior may be required to leave the Prom if she or he is dressed inappropriately.
- Social distancing guidelines must be adhered to. Masks are to be worn at all times when you are not consuming food or drink. Eating and drinking must only take place in designated areas.
