Teaching and Learning

This spring our 9th, 10th and 11th graders will take standardized tests. These tests will be formal tests that allow us to seek accommodations for our students with a learning plan. Those accommodations, particularly for 10th and 11th graders, need to be approved by either ACT (11th graders) or PSAT (10th graders). Once a student has been approved by SAT, the accommodations are valid for all future College Board exams including the PSAT/NMSQT, SAT and Advanced Placement (AP) Exams.

We strongly encourage students to use their accommodations, particularly on high stake tests like the ACT, SAT and AP. This allows the best chance of success.

In the fall we had parents opt in to the accommodations. Going forward, we will assume your daughter will test with her allowed accommodations, unless you specifically opt out of the accommodations. If you do <u>not</u> want your daughter to use her allowed accommodations, please email Rankin Program Director, Ms. O'Donnell at <u>bodonnell@reshs.org</u>. The deadline to decline accommodations is Wednesday, December 1, 2021. This date may seem early for a spring test, but the approval process is time consuming and we want to do all that we can to provide the best testing experience

possible for your daughter.
