Dear RES parents,

I am happy to report that our work together to manage the COVID-19 Omicron variant is keeping positive cases below five percent. This past week we had 3 students and 1 staff member test positive for COVID-19. This Friday, January 28th, will be our last day of the 2:27 p.m. dismissal; we will resume 3:00 p.m. dismissal time on Monday, January 31, 2022. We will also have one (1) final half day on Wednesday, January 26th with school ending at 12:15 p.m.

### COVID-19 VACCINATION SURVEY

Your daughter received the link to the COVID-19 Vaccination Survey on Friday. If she didn't update the information, please complete the survey before she comes to school on Monday, January 24th.

### UNIFORM POLICY REMINDERS

The uniform and dress code policies provide multiple options to our students so that they can be comfortable even when the weather is unseasonably cold. This has been discussed with students to help them in following uniform expectations. The school polo and skirt can be supplemented with the following optional apparel:

- Dennis Uniform fleece top
- Dennis Uniform ¼ zip sweatshirt
- Long sleeve T-shirts (red, white, black, or grey) and/or thermal shirt under the polo
- Leggings or tights can be worn under the skirt

Students also have the option of wearing Dennis uniform black slacks.

In the event that students feel cold in a particular classroom despite wearing a combination of the items listed above, a teacher may give permission to a student to wear an additional piece of clothing if the room is cold. That item would be removed in other teachers' classrooms unless they grant permission, as well.

During the pandemic, a tight-fitting mask is required at all times, except when the student is seated and eating lunch.

### CUMULATIVE GPAs UPDATE

### FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE REMINDERS

Resurrection is now accepting need-based tuition assistance applications for the 2022-23 school year. Resurrection is managing the application process using FACTS. **The FACTS application for current families is due on February 4, 2022. If you are a current parent and will have a freshman attending RES in the 2022-23 school year, you must adhere to the due dates outlined for incoming freshmen. FACTS applications for the incoming freshmen (9th graders) are due on January 17, 2022.

**Scholarship applications are due on February 7, 2022.** Students must complete the General Application if they are applying for a scholarship.
