Parents and students -

A family of Resurrection College Prep notified school leadership today, May 14, 2021, that a student tested positive for COVID-19 from a test administered on 5/13/2021. We have assurances from our staff that our safety standards (masks, social distancing and hand sanitation) were followed the entire time students were on campus. We are unable to provide any additional information regarding this individual due to federal privacy laws. The student was last on campus 5/10/2021.

What does this mean for you?

The Chicago Department of Public Health only requires quarantine if you have been exposed to someone who is Covid positive for 15+ minutes within 6 feet. Students who were considered in close contact with the student who has tested positive for Covid have been notified, and their parents have been contacted. The appropriate measures were taken.

It is important that everyone continues to remain diligent in monitoring for symptoms or fever. If those symptoms develop, please do not send your daughter to school. Rather, remain home that day and report the symptoms to the school. The school may require that you take a Covid test before returning.
