Dear Resurrection families,

On behalf of the entire Resurrection community, I thank you for choosing to entrust and partner with Resurrection College Prep for your daughter's educational and spiritual formation. This trust and partnership are extraordinary privileges that we value! The Resurrection College Prep High School Board of Directors has set tuition for the 2022-2023 school year; tuition will increase by approximately four percent totalling \$13,750.

This past year, we continued to improve the educational experience for our young women. To ensure that experience, Resurrection:

- increased our technological infrastructure to support the heightened demand for devices on the network
- adopted PowerSchool to facilitate communication with our students and families better
- re-established relationships with on-site food service providers

Looking ahead to the 2022-2023, we are planning on making improvements to our student classroom experience including:

- the launch of a three-year learning spaces upgrade
- adding a second STREAM lab
- enhancement and modernization of the athletic training facility
- increase compensation to our valued faculty

To maintain the school's commitment to providing access to students from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds and to support those families suffering from the adverse economic effects of the pandemic, Resurrection will also increase need-based financial aid in the 2022-2023 school year.

With a tuition gap of approximately \$3,000 per student for the 2022-2023 school year and the impact of the pandemic on Resurrection community members, we continue to encourage our families and the greater Resurrection community, to support our annual giving program, commensurate with their ability to give.

Please know that we are always available to support you, as our means allow, in the education of your daughter! Each of our students' hopes, dreams, and future success is and will always be our central focus.
