The Jessica Martin Scholarship was established by an anonymous donor to honor the life and joy Jessica shared with the world.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- 1. Be a junior level student in good standing at Resurrection College Prep High School and enrolled for the following school year.
- 2. Maintain a C average or better.
- 3. Demonstrate financial need.*
- 4. Be involved in at least one extra-curricular activity in school or service activity in school, parish, or community.
- 5. Emulate the qualities Jessica Martin possessed: responsibility, friendliness, exhibit a love of life, and maintains a positive attitude.

*Need will be assessed by the FACTS Student Aid Application

- ✓ The Jessica Martin Scholarship is a one-time award.
- ✓ One scholarship is awarded annually in the amount of \$3,000.
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
