School Closure & E-Learning Days

As you know, due to the COVID-19 Coronavirus outbreak and following guidance from the Illinois Department of Public Health, Chicago Department of Public Health, and the Archdiocese Office of Catholic Schools, Resurrection College Prep High School's campus is closed until further notice. **All activities and events are canceled until further notice, including all athletic games and practices.** See complete information <u>HERE</u>. E-Learning Days begin Monday, March 16, 2020, and access to the building and grounds is limited to maintenance and essential staff on an as-need basis.

E-Learning Days – March 16-20, 2020

Based on the rapidly evolving health concerns due to the ongoing coronavirus COVID-19 outbreak, we have taken proactive steps to move to an e-learning platform. <u>E-Learning Days</u> begin **Monday**, **March 16, 2020.** During e-learning days, students will complete assigned coursework from home. Students received instruction on Friday, March 13, 2020, regarding access to e-learning tools and expectations. **Parents, guardians and students should carefully review the information** <u>HERE</u>.

Each morning, students will find an organizational workload assignment via Schoology (from their seminar class). From 8:20 - 9:05 am, students are required to review the day's learning tasks, complete the workload assignment that identifies the learning and work they expect to complete, and then submit it through Schoology. The submission of this document is what will be utilized for attendance purposes.

Unless specifically stated by a teacher, there is no set time when students must access and complete assignments during the e-learning day, but **teachers will be online and available for instructional support during the times when they would normally be accessible**. A teacher may require students to meet and complete work during a scheduled period, but the teacher is required to give students two days' notice about the required meeting.

We will follow a modified version of our current Red/White day block schedule during e-learning days during the week of **March 16-20, 2020**. See the schedule <u>HERE</u>. **Please note, although Friday, March 20, 2020, was scheduled to be a non-attendance day for students, it will be an e-learning day.** On Friday, March 20th, students should expect to log-in by 8:20 am and submit the day's workload assignment via Schoology by 9:05 am.

Parents/guardians - If your student has a medical appointment or some other circumstance that will interfere with participation in their classes or the completion of required tasks/assignments, please send an email to the teacher and the following email address: <u>elearning@reshs.org</u>.

Please continue to visit the <u>Resurrection website</u> for information. As always, all forms of communication between teachers and students will be through school-approved methods, such as Schoology or the student's official Resurrection email address.

Thank you to students, teachers and parents for your patience and flexibility as we transition into this elearning platform during this time of crisis as we all navigate this environment. As always, we ask that you keep all those impacted by the virus in your prayers.

Resurrection Precautions

All school assemblies and liturgies have been canceled for the month of April, including the Ladies Day Mass & Brunch and the Alumnae Wall of Honor event. As a precaution, and following the example of other institutions, when the campus re-opens we will continue to implement procedures to limit the access to our building of people other than faculty, staff, and students, as well as modifying any large group setting.
