

The Mark Teach Scholarship

The Mark Teach Scholarship is named for the son of Gordon and Mary Teach. Gordon Teach was a friend of the Sisters of the Resurrection for over 35 years, beginning when he first served as trustee for Resurrection Health Care. Highly impressed with the various functions that he attended at Resurrection College Prep High School over the years, he felt inspired to help with the Sisters' mission of educating young women. The hard work of the Sisters played a large part in Mr. Teach's decision to establish a scholarship. The scholarship is named in hnor of his son, Mark, who died in infancy.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- 1. Be a current freshman, sophomore, or junior student in good standing at Resurrection College Prep High School and enrolled for the following school year.
- 2. Demonstrate financial need.*
- 3. Have current (or recent) volunteer/work experience at Resurrection Medical Center.
- 4. Have an interest in pursuing a health-related career.

*Need will be assessed by the FACTS Student Aid Application

- ✓ The Mark Teach Scholarship is a one-time award.
- ✓ One scholarship is awarded annually in the amount of \$2,000.
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
